




If you spot potentially illegal content, and you would like to report it, press and hold on the content, or tap the Share button on the right-hand side of the screen, to open a small pop-up menu — this may vary depending on whether you are using an Android device or an iPhone

When the menu opens, tap the flag labelled **Report**.





Next, you'll be asked to select a reason for your report. Select **Report illegal content**. If you don't see it at first, try scrolling down to see all the available options.







You'll then see a list containing various categories of potentially illegal content.

Select the category that best fits the content you want to report, or, if you're not sure, select Other illegal content.

Depending on which category you choose, you may be asked to make some further selections, before reaching a reporting form.





On the form, complete all the required sections marked with a red asterisk (\*), providing as much detail as you can, before submitting.

It is also helpful to provide details of the law you suspect the content may be breaking, if you know it, but this is optional.





Following submission, you should receive an automated notification, confirming that your report has been submitted.

It may also suggest some other actions you can take while you await the outcome of your report.







Following Tik Tok's review, you should receive a notification of the outcome and any action that has been taken in respect of the reported content, as well as any options for appeal.







For some categories, you may be asked to make some further selections, like these, before reaching the submission page.







### **How to Report Harmful Content**

It may also suggest some other actions you can take, while you await the outcome of your report.




